


Guide to Linking Existing Savings Accounts to Max

What to do after linking your existing online savings accounts to your Max Dashboard




Accounts opened using the Max Common Application will automatically link to Max and to your linked checking account, so no further setup is required for those accounts.



Linking Your Checking Account to Ally

1) At the top of the Ally Bank website, select "Transfers" then "Bank Transfers"

2) Click on "Link other accounts"








3) Select "Add Accounts"

4) Select "Checking" as Account Type and fill in the requested information

You can find your routing and account number on the Checking tab atop your Max Dashboard.








Linking Your Checking Account to Ally

- 5) Verify your account:
- instantly with your bank's login credentials
- with bank deposits

or

6) If you select "Verify with bank deposits,"
Ally will make two small deposits into your checking account; you will then have to verify the amounts by logging into your checking account in a few days







Linking Your Checking Account to AMEX




Linking Your Checking Account to AMEX



Important information about verifying your account:

For security reasons, we use test deposits as part of the external account verification process. 2 to 3 business days after you add a link to your Barclays account, we'll make two test deposits of less than \$1.00 into your external account.

We'll then ask you to log in to your Barclays account and report the amounts of those test deposits. After you have confirmed the test deposits amounts, you'll be able to begin transferring money between your Barclays account and your external account.

We will send you an email with the verification step after the test deposits are made.
